Nineteen people die with COVID-19 complications; 393 people test positive

EDINBURG – Nineteen residents have died due to complications related to COVID-19 and 393 people learned they tested positive for the virus, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Friday. The total number of positive cases is 7,727.

"Each day we are losing more of our fellow county residents to this deadly virus. I send my deepest condolences to the families of these victims," said Cortez. "Please remember to take personal responsibility for you and family by continuing to use proper hygiene, social distancing, and, most importantly, wearing a mask."

There are currently 798 people hospitalized with complications from the virus; 198 of those cases are being treated in intensive care units. There are 4,696 net active cases and 1,124 test results are pending. Fifty-three people were released from isolation on Friday meaning that they have been symptom-free for 10 days, including three days without a fever.

There will not be a report on Saturday. We will resume on Sunday, July 12, 2020.
