### Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Related Deaths

Cameron County has received confirmation of fifteen additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County Residents. The individuals were a 48-year old female from Harlingen, a 57-year old female from Olmito, and a 60-year old, 71-year old, 72-year old, 77-year old and 84-year old females from Brownsville. In addition, there was 50-year old, 60-year old, 64-year old, 67-year old, 71-year old, 72-year old, 80-year old and 90-year old males from Brownsville. These individuals all passed away at Valley Baptist Medical Center in Brownsville. This raises the number of COVID-19 related deaths in Cameron County to 126.

Cameron County has also received confirmation of an additional 307 laboratory reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 6,520 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional ninety-seven (97) individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 3,056.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with the six nursing home facilities and one detention center in addressing the COVID-19 outbreaks. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Port Isabel Service Processing Center has 12 employees and 81 detainees who have tested positive.
