Ten more people in Hidalgo County test positive for COVID-19

EDINBURG – As the number of people overall who have been tested in Hidalgo County surpassed the 8,000 mark, an additional ten people in Hidalgo County tested positive for COVID-19, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Friday.

"We will see an influx of positive cases as more tests are administered through recently opened testing sites. It's important to continue protecting yourselves and each other during this pandemic," said Cortez. "Wear your face coverings and practice physical distancing when out in public."

Thirteen people remain hospitalized with complications from the virus; three of those cases are being treated in intensive care units. Seven people were released from isolation meaning that they have been symptom free for 10 days, including three days without a fever. There are currently 189 active cases.
