Hidalgo County sees 11th COVID-19 related death

EDINBURG – A 60-year-old McAllen woman with a history of medical complications died Monday after testing positive for the COVID-19 virus, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said. Her death brings to 11 the total number of people who have died in Hidalgo County after testing positive for this strain of coronavirus.

"Today's tragic development illustrates the importance of the continued steps that we should be taking in protecting each other from the virus," said Cortez. "We can all play a role in saving lives through physical distancing, wearing face coverings and practicing healthy behaviors. I extend my sincere condolences to this woman's family."

Twenty-six people have been hospitalized with complications from the virus; three of those cases are being treated in intensive care units.

Nine people were released from isolation on Monday meaning that they have been symptom free for 10 days, including three days without a fever. There are currently 218 active and 3,404 test results are pending.
