Thirty-eight more people test positive for COVID-19 in Hidalgo County

EDINBURG – Thirty-eight more people in Hidalgo County have tested positive for the COVID-19 virus, bringing the total number of known cases in the county to 842, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Wednesday.

Forty-four people have been hospitalized with complications from the virus; five of those cases are being treated in intensive care units.

“In the past two weeks we have seen hospitalizations nearly triple,” Judge Cortez said. “The virus continues to spread in our community. We urge residents to do their part to stop the spread by maintaining good hygiene, wearing facial coverings and avoiding large crowds.”

There are currently 1,585 tests pending, a total of 366 active cases and 15 people were released from isolation today.
