Hidalgo health department reports 18 more COVID-19 related deaths, 183 new positive cases

EDINBURG – Officials with the Hidalgo County Health and Human Services Department reported 18 more deaths due to complications from COVID-19 and another 183 new positive cases, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Tuesday. That brings the total death count from this virus to 1,784 and the total known positive cases in the county to 32,813.

“The head of our health department said today that the virus remains active in our community,” Judge Cortez said. “I urge people to remember this and to take the necessary precautions, especially with regard to wearing facial coverings and avoiding crowds.”

A total of 187 people are now in area hospitals because of COVID-19; 62 of those patients are being treated in intensive care units.
