The 66 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 52,508 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 90 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 48,258.

Cameron County Public Health is reporting an additional nineteen (19) COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. These reports occurred in the last month and were retrieved from the Texas Department of State Health Services vital statistics data which was temporarily unavailable. Of these deaths, 17 were not vaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,938.
