Hidalgo health department reports 3 more deaths related to COVID-19 and 145 new positive cases

EDINBURG – Officials with the Hidalgo County Health and Human Services Department reported 3 more deaths related to COVID-19 and 145 new known positive cases of the virus, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Friday. The result is a total of 1,895 recorded deaths related to the outbreak of this disease and 34,179 known total positive cases.

"I extend my condolences to the family and friends of those who have died," Judge Cortez said.
