The 107 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 50,403 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 118 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 45,977.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of ten (10) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. All reported deaths were unvaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,806.
