Cameron County Daily COVID-19 Report

PLEASE NOTE: Due to a system maintenance on the Cameron County server, access to the National Electronic Disease Surveillance System (NEDSS), which provides COVID-19 case reports to Cameron County Public Health, was disabled. According to the Texas Department of State Health Services, it may take a week to be able to access the system. As approximately 60% of the daily COVID-19 case reports Cameron County Public Health provides are obtained from NEDSS, the case numbers being reported will be low until the system is enabled.

Cameron County has received confirmation of an additional 126 laboratory reports of COVID-19, which includes:
