The 16 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 54,406 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 32 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 51,257.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of three (3) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. Of these reported death, two were not vaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 2,027.
