Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Related Death

Cameron County has received confirmation of an additional COVID-19 related death of a Cameron County resident. The individual was a 74-year old male resident of Spanish Meadows in Brownsville and was a previously reported case. This raises the number of COVID-19 related deaths in Cameron County to 71.

Cameron County has also received confirmation of an additional 123 case reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 3,120 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional one hundred and five (105) individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 2,285.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with the seven nursing home facilities and one detention center in addressing the COVID-19 outbreaks. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Veranda Nursing Home has included 35 employees and 64 residents who have tested positive, including 11 who have passed away. Spanish Meadows in Brownsville also has 6 employees and 11 residents who have tested positive, including 3 who have passed away. The Rio at Fox Hollow in Brownsville has 35 employees and 36 residents who have tested positive, including 7 who passed away. Alta Vista in Brownsville has 1 employee and 4 residents who have tested positive. Harlingen Nursing and Rehabilitation Center currently has 4 employees and 2 residents who have tested positive. Ebony Lake Nursing and Rehabilitation has 1 employee and 4 residents who have tested positive. Brownsville Nursing and Rehabilitation Center currently has 2 employees and 1 resident who have tested positive. In addition, Port Isabel Service Processing Center has 11 employees and 75 detainees who have tested positive.

As part of the COVID-19 action response plan, Cameron County Public Health is conducting epidemiological investigations, contact tracing as needed, and continues to monitor the situation.
