The 420 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 45,887 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 204 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 41,754.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of four (4) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. This raises the total number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,723.

In addition, 82.35% of the population 65 years and older in Cameron County is fully vaccinated and 90.78% has received at least one dose.
