The 200 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 47,331 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 45 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 42,612.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of one (1) additional COVID-19 related death of a Cameron County resident. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 1,739.
