CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

I, the undersigned complainant state that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. On or about March 30, 2020 in Live Oak County, in the Southern District of Texas defendant(s) did, unlawfully escape from the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons located at US Highway 72 West in Three Rivers, Texas.

In violation of Title 18 United States Code, Section(s) 751.

I further state that I am a(n) Supervisory Deputy U.S. Marshal and that this complaint is based on the following facts : On April 25, 2019, RODRIGUEZ plead guilty to count one (1) in the Western District of Texas, (Case# 5:18-CR-00386-XR(1)) in violation of Title 21 United States Code, Section 841 (A)(1) and Title 21 United States Code, Section 841(B)(1)(A), Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine.

On August 25, 2019, RODRIGUEZ was sentenced to one hundred & twenty months (120) to the Federal Bureau of Prisons by District Judge Xavier Rodriguez. RODRIGUEZ was lawfully confined at the direction of the United States Attorney General upon his conviction of Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine.

On March 30, 2020, at approximately 5:20am, RODRIGUEZ was discovered missing after an unannounced count was conducted at the camp in Three Rivers, Texas. Staff conducted a building check of all common areas of the camp, with negative results. RODRIGUEZ was placed on escape status on March 30, 2020, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 751(a). RODRIGUEZ S whereabouts is unknown at this time.
