Governor Greg Abbott has announced that Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) will receive nearly \$54 million in federal funds to support older Texans and people with disabilities during the COVID-19 response. The funding will be used to support programs and services administered by the state's 28 <u>Area Agencies on Aging</u> (AAA) such as home delivered meals, help with household chores, assistance with groceries, and respite care or other services for family caregivers. Funding will also be used to support the <u>Long-Term Care Ombudsman</u>, which provides advocacy and complaint resolution services on behalf of residents in long-term care facilities.
