

Project Need:

The project is needed due to traffic operational deficiencies, the existing roadway does not meet current design standards, lacks turning lanes, and lacks pedestrian/bicycle accommodations.

Project Purpose:

The purpose of the project is to reduce congestion, improve mobility, and improve safety for vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

Project Description:

The proposed improvements would widen and reconstruct the existing two-lane road to four lanes with a continuous center turn lane, a shared-use path for pedestrians and cyclists, and a sidewalk within a proposed 100-foot-wide right of way. Drainage would be provided by a storm drain system. In addition, approximately 440 feet of incidental construction within existing ROW would be required east of FM 907 to ensure proper roadway transition. Intersection improvements would be included at Veterans Blvd., Raul Longoria Rd., Cesar Chavez Rd., and FM 907.

Anticipated Project Schedule

- Environmental Approval: Nov. 2025
- Design 100% Complete: Feb. 2027
- Begin ROW Acquisition: Oct. 2027
- Begin Construction: Aug. 2030
