

## Traffic pattern changes to impact travel along the I-2/I-69C Pharr Interchange corridor this week

**PHARR** – Traffic pattern changes scheduled for the I-2/I-69C Pharr Interchange Project corridor could impact travel for commuters this week and this weekend, in San Juan, Pharr, and McAllen.

- ⇒ Beginning this **Wednesday, June 12**, the eastbound I-2 exit ramp to Stewart Road, in San Juan, will permanently close.
- ⇒ **On Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, by 8 a.m.**, a new westbound entrance ramp to access the I-2 main lanes will open between Jackson Road and Jackson Avenue, in McAllen.
- ⇒ Soon thereafter, the existing westbound I-2 entrance ramp between Jackson Avenue and McColl Road, in McAllen, will permanently close.
- ⇒ **On Sunday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, by 6 a.m.**, the Edinburg-to-McAllen flyover lanes, in Pharr, will connect directly to the current I-2 westbound main lanes.
- ⇒ The existing westbound I-2 entrance ramp just west of Sugar Road, in Pharr, will close temporarily. A new entrance ramp is expected to open in this area in August.

All dates and times for the scheduled changes are tentative and subject to change.
