### **Solid Waste Disposal**

In order to safeguard the public health and ensure waste disposal sites for residents who live in the rural and unincorporated areas of the county, Hidalgo County has approved a Solid Waste Disposal Program .

#### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

This program requires a vehicle permit which can be purchased at your corresponding Hidalgo County Precinct Office. Permits can be paid in cash, money order (preferred), credit cards or debit cards.

To purchase or renew a permit, you must:

- Fill out an application
- Provide proof of Hidalgo County rural residency (current water bill or water company receipt)
- Provide any form of personal identification with corresponding name & address same as bill
- Provide the year, make, model, color and license plate number of the vehicle being used

#### **PERMIT FEE**

Amount	\$25	\$50	\$75	\$100
Duration	90 Days	180 Days	270 Days	365 Days

You will have access to any of the thirteen (13) Collection Stations located countywide.

Once the permit is purchased, residents will receive only one (1) permit/sticker. This permit is not transferable and limited to one (1) vehicle.

In order to obtain disposal site services, stickers must be adhered on the upper left corner inside the vehicle windshield.

Residents can purchase a user permit at their corresponding Hidalgo County Administrative Precinct Office.

#### **QUALIFIED RESIDENTS**

Only Hidalgo County rural and unincorporated residents will qualify for a permit .

#### NOTICE

As per Health & Safety Code Section 365.012, a person commits an offense and is in violation of the law, if the person:

- Disposes, allows, receives, transports or authorizes the disposal of solid waste at a place that is not an approved solid waste site
- Disposes solid waste in a dumpster that is controlled by someone else without permission

An offense under this section shall result in prosecution.

#### **ACCEPTED ITEMS**

- Residential Waste: includes normal household garbage (paper, plastic, cans, food and vegetable scraps)
- Tires: Only four (4) regular tires per month
- **Bulky Items:** Tanks, mattresses, chairs, furniture, electronics and couches
- White goods: Bath tub, heater, hot water heater, refrigerator, sink or washer and dryer (Freon must be removed previously)
- Scrap Metal: Metal that can be sold as scrap
- Brush and Yard Waste (only at selected stations): leaves, grass clippings, tree trimmings and brush. Brush should be cut in 3 to 4 foot lengths and securely tied

#### NON ACCEPTED ITEMS

Commercial
Construction Waste:
building material, brick,
concrete, shingles, wood,
gypsum, and sheet rock



Must be taken to nearest landfill

- **Automotive Parts:** car batteries, fenders, vehicle doors, body and frame parts, engines,
- transmissions, canoes, boats and commercial truck/tractor tires

Hazardous Waste: pesticides, fertilizers, herbicides, chemicals, cleaners, paint thinners, toxins, poisons, asbestos, petroleum products (such as gas, oil and kerosene), drums, paint cans,



liquids or solvents of any kind, items with Freon or dead animals.
